

# HOW TO' GUIDE: BAGGING & PLANTING

## **Equipment:**

- Hessian bags
- 1/16th tsp measuring spoons
- Sterile sand
- Trowels
- · Bale arm crates
- Masks, snorkels, fins
- Weight belts & weights
- Paddle board (optional)

# Timing:

Once seeds are bagged plant within 24 hours to prevent the seeds from drying out.

#### Note:

If you wish to use a boat for planting seagrass, you need to obtain a license from Marine Scotland.

### Top Tip:

Bagging up sand and seeds is a great activity for volunteers of all ages and abilities, and as it's fairly time consuming this helps take pressure off the core team.

Count out 50 seeds and put them into the teaspoon measure to give you an idea of how full the scoop should look.
