

'HOW TO' GUIDE: STORAGE & PROCESSING

Equipment:

- Processing unit
- Siphon hose
- Long-handled fine mesh net
- 1/4" garden riddle
- Bucket
- 5 litre jug
- 2 litre mixing bowl
- Large fine mesh bags
- Digital scales (0.01g accuracy)

Timing:

Seed spathes will take around 2 months in the tanks to release all of their seeds.

Note:

Sweep the tanks to collect seeds every 1 - 2 weeks so that they do not sit in the rotting vegetative matter on the bottom of the tanks for too long.

Carry out a 50% water change every 2-3 days to prevent the water going anoxic and damaging the seeds.

Constant aeration of the processing tanks promotes water circulation and helps to prevent the water going anoxic.

Top Tip:

When siphoning water from tanks during water changes ensure siphon hose is off the bottom of the tank to avoid sucking up seeds.
