


# HEALTH SURVEY

Decide where you want to conduct your survey.

1



Swim to and identify one edge of the habitat.

2

record the start time and start depth of your survey

3



Use a quadrat for measuring percentage cover and/or shoot density

4

Measuring the length and width of the seagrass blades

5



Take 10 quadrat or blade measurements, randomly or at intervals along a transect line

6

Taking photos of the quadrats will help calculate percentage cover from the photos.

7



Record the finish time and end depth of your survey.

8

Upon completion of the survey, record the gps coordinates of your survey area.

9



Upload your data on the Great Seagrass Survey portal.
